



What is Savoy Automobile Museum?

- We are rooted in automotive history – allowing visitors to explore the history and diversity of automobiles through changing exhibits, educational programs and engaging experiences
- We are a part of Georgia Museums, Inc., the same organization that oversees Booth Western Art Museum, Bartow History Museum, and Tellus Science Museum
- The Museum will be located on 35+ acres at the intersection of US Highway 411 and GA Highway 20 in Cartersville, Georgia.
- Our footprint will be comprised of three buildings:
 1. The main museum structure will be 60,000+ square feet with four exhibition galleries, a presentation theatre, and on-site café.
 2. A storage garage/shop area behind the main museum that will be upwards of 30,000 square feet.
 3. There will be an outdoor pavilion structure for car shows, concerts, cruise-ins, etc., at roughly 12,000+ square feet.
 4. The grounds are being constructed to be conducive for car shows year round.

We are currently grading the property and once we begin the physical building process, we estimate an 18 month build time...tentative opening late 2020/early 2021
